Student Contract

GOAL: Participants in grades 9-11 will begin or continue to learn about different types of colleges and universities they would like to apply/attend through a weeklong of college visits and an overnight college visit.

REQUIREMENTS: Be a high school student in good academic standing. Candidates must also demonstrate initiative, maturity and Independence to be invited on the tour. They must be able to work well with others and / or by themselves.

DRESS CODE: Participants must adhere to the dress code during college tours. Tour attire consists of slacks/khakis or skirts (professional length); polo/button down shirts with sleeves, and comfortable closed toe shoes (no sneakers). Proper personal hygiene is a must. Hair must be neatly combed or styled. No hats or do-rags are to be worn indoors. All cell phones must be turned off or kept on silent mode.

HOURS: Each person is expected to attend all pre-tour meetings. College tour April 21-April 25, 2015.

Communication: All participants must have an email address, status updates will be sent via email. Additionally participants will be required to respond to emails from YES staff within 48 business hours.

CONDUCT: All participants are expected to act with dignity and decorum. Inappropriate behavior or language will not be tolerated. On college campuses, students are required to adhere to all of the campus rules and expectations. Remember you are not only representing yourself but also YES. Participants of different genders are not allowed to visit each other's rooms while at Swann. Participants of different genders must stay in common areas. Participants are expected to be on time for all college tour departures and to respect the nightly quiet /lights out time. All participants will adhere to college dorm rules and expectations. All participants will share in the responsibilities for Swann as outlined by the College Prep Fellow.

PARTICIPANTS WHO DO NOT MEET THE EXPECTATIONS WILL NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE COLLEGE TOUR AND/OR WILL BE SENT HOME FROM THE TOUR WITHOUT A REFUND.
