Impact Intern (Summer 2024)

Youth Enrichment Services inspires youth through outdoor experiences and leadership opportunities that build confidence and prepare them to summit life's challenges.

Job Description & Duties:

Impact Interns will document OA (Outdoor Adventure) trips using pictures, videos, interviews, and surveys to capture the summer's adventures. They will also work collaboratively throughout the summer to create a YES Impact project. May assist directly with day camp programming at times.

The Impact Intern's responsibilities include:

- Work approximately 20-25 hours each week (earning \$15/hour for six weeks)
- Take candid, group, and action photos during OA trips
- Conduct OA trip surveys and interviews as needed
- Collaborate on a summer-long impact project with fellow impact interns
- Assist in outreach efforts with YES staff for upcoming programs
- Assist in YES day camp programs as needed
- Serve as a role model to youth enrolled in YES programs
- Be an ambassador of YES by actively showing respect for yourself, others, and the environment (including adhering to, and educating others about, Leave No Trace outdoor ethics principles)
- Attend staff meetings, supervision, trainings, and professional development outings as required
- Other duties as assigned

Applicants must fit the following criteria to be eligible:

- Be between the ages of 15 to 19
- Full-time residents of Boston
- Authorized to work in the United States
- Have experience using digital media software and social media to edit pictures, videos, and audio recordings
- Able to provide a current physical (or obtain one)
- Able to provide current immunization records
- Able to obtain a work permit by June 17th
- Able to attend onboarding/training days (specific dates TBD)
- Able to work 20-25 hours per week between 8:30 AM-5:00 PM, Monday-Friday starting July 8th through August 16th, and be able to attend MLK Scholars events as scheduled
- Have a personal bank account (or be willing to open one) Paychecks will be direct deposit

Applicants should demonstrate professionalism, a love of nature and the outdoors, and a desire to work with youth.

Priority is given to teens who have participated in LC (Leadership Corps) and/or served as an Impact Intern or

Outdoor Adventure Leader in previous summers.

Deadline: Applications will be reviewed on a priority basis until Friday, March 22nd. Applications will continue to be accepted on a rolling basis until all positions are filled.
