- Teens enrolled in grades 9-12, Boston residents only. (Preference given to teens living in Mattapan, Roxbury, Dorchester, and Jamaica Plain.

Deadline/Dates:

- Deadline - September 27th
- Start week of October 15; End week of March 24

Orientation:

Program Components:



- Rental Shops – All LCs volunteer in the rental shop on their chosen shop night once a week
- LCs will choose at least one of three tracks:
 - **Downhill Ski or Snowboard Confidence Coach** - teach others how to ski/ride
 - **Cross Country Ski Confidence Coach** - teach others how to cross-country ski
 - **Impact intern** - document SnowSports trips through photos, videos, interviews, surveys, and help create content for YES social media pages
 - **Youth Advisory Council (YAC)**- Plans appreciation events, represent YES youth in the community and lift up youth voice
