

Outdoor Adventure Leader (Summer 2023)

Youth Enrichment Services inspires youth through outdoor experiences and leadership opportunities that build confidence and prepare them to summit life's challenges.

Job Description & Duties:

Outdoor Adventure Leaders provide a variety of support to YES's Outdoor Adventure program, which offers youth the opportunity to get outside, have fun, and stay fit.

The Outdoor Adventure Leader's primary responsibilities include:

- Work approximately 20-25 hours each week (earning \$15.00/hour for seven weeks)
- Participate in all assigned shifts
 - 1-2 Outdoor Adventure trips per week (full day, 8.5 hour shifts, 8:30 AM 5 PM)
 - o 1-2 office days per week (shorter shifts between 8:30 AM − 5 PM)
- Learn and instruct youth on the basics of mountain biking, hiking, kayaking and rock climbing
- Collaborate with adult Activity Captains to plan, organize, and lead programs and outdoor experiences
- Serve as a leader, mentor, and role model to youth enrolled in YES programs
- Be an ambassador of YES by actively showing respect for self, others, and the environment (including adhering to, and educating others about, Leave No Trace outdoor ethics principles)
- Attend staff meetings, seminars, and trainings as required
- Manage the safety of participants and administer first aid if necessary
- Other duties as assigned

Applicants must fit the following criteria to be eligible:

- Be between the ages of 16 to 18
- Full-time residents of Boston
- Authorized to work in the United States
- Able to obtain a work permit by June 10th
- Able to work 20-25 hours per week between Monday-Friday starting June 29th through August 18th, and attend Friday MLK Scholars Forums/Events (exact times/dates to be announced at a later date)
- Willing to work in an outdoor setting for up to 8.5 hours per day
- Able to travel to and from Youth Enrichment Services (412 Massachusetts Avenue)
- Able to attend overnight trips to Swann Lodge in Monterey, Massachusetts
 - Outdoor Adventure Leaders will be expected to attend overnight sessions for half a week at least once per summer season
- Able to provide a current physical (or obtain one)
- Able to provide current immunization records
- Have a personal bank account (or be willing to open one)
- Able to provide proof of vaccination from COVID-19

Applicants should possess professionalism, a love of nature and the outdoors, and a desire to work with youth.

Priority is given to teens that have participated in LC (Leadership Corps) and/or served as an Impact Intern or Outdoor

Adventure Leader in previous summers.

How to Apply:

Complete all sections of the online YES teen staff application. If invited for an interview, you will be asked to submit three references.

Deadline:

Applications will be accepted on a priority basis until **Friday, March 31**st. Applications will continue to be accepted on a rolling basis until all positions are filled.
